How can I get involved in the city in which I live?

In a city, people have several opportunities to make a difference and change things, especially when it comes to political participation. In Wuppertal, there are a large number of committees that make many decisions or prepare them. The Integration Committee stands for the idea that all people in Wuppertal have an equal opportunity for development and participation in all areas of political, cul-tural and social life.

What is the task of an integration committee?

The task of the integration committee is to promote the interests, needs and concerns of people with an immigration history in the city. This may involve things such as intercultural exchange, multilingu-alism or problems in terms of inequality or discrimination.

The Integration Committee

- represents the interests of people with an immigration history in the city council and contributes to ensuring that a city can work together through diversity.
- contributes to the development of concrete integration offers in the city and that sufficient resources are made available for implementation.
- advises and accompanies the work of the administration in all questions pertaining to migration and integration.

Who can elect the Integration committee?

Eligible to vote and/or be elected are people who have a foreign nationality or have been naturalized in Germany and have been resident in Germany for at least one year, who live in Wuppertal and are at least 16 years old.

With this in mind, we call on all people with an immigration history in Wuppertal to exercise their right to vote or to make use of the existing possibilities so that the Integration Committee can gain more political power.

So please get involved! Make you decision count and go and vote!
