What you must know about vaccinating against Corona

Why is a vaccination important?

- With the vaccination your immune system is prepared for the pathogen (e.g. Corona).
- This way you protect not only yourself efficiently but also other people, who might not be able to get vaccinated due to other illnesses!
- The more people get vaccinated the less the infection can spread (also called herd immunity).

Am I eligible for a vaccination?

Yes! The vaccination prioritization is canceled.

Since the 26th June 2021 vaccinations are accessible for all citizens over the age of 16 years.

Where can I get the vaccination and how can I make an appointment?

- **The address of the vaccination centre is: Rainer-Gruenter-Str. 21, 42119 Wuppertal**
Do not come until the appointed time.
- **IMPORTANT:** Persons who have only recently recovered from a Corona infection cannot be vaccinated. The infection must date back at least six months.
- **General practitioners may also vaccinate. Get the information from your GP.**

What documents do I need for a vaccination?

- an official identity document with a photograph
- appointment confirmation
- If available: valid international vaccination certificate (yellow booklet)
- Vaccination documents: Information sheet, Medical history and Declaration of Content. Bring the filled in forms in duplicate to your appointment, please
- Proof of first vaccination (if it has already occurred)
- If available: medical records (for example heart disease record card, diabetic passport or medication plan)

Are there any side effects due to the vaccination?

- There may be side effects. This is normal as the immune system is working. In most cases these side effects are not dangerous and disappear after a few days.
- Side effects that may occur are for example: fever, headache, pain in a limb, redness, pain and swellings.
- In case of more serious side effects you must contact your GP.
