Dear readers,

after a short summer break you now receive the latest edition of the newsletter from the Department Integration and Immigration. The newsletter informs you on the current developments concerning Corona and furthermore offers a short overview of further information and offers in Wuppertal.

Please note: The Corona regulations are constantly adapted to the infection process. Therefore there may be further changes at short notice. (status: Sept. 8th, 2021)

General information

Corona information (Update Sept. 2nd)

- The latest Corona protection regulation has been in place since August 20th and is valid for the time being until Sept. 17th, 2021 incl.
- According to the resolutions there are no longer several incidence levels, but only one at 35.
- If the 7 day-incidence rises above 35 in a district or a city the „3G-Rule“ applies (3 G means: **g**eimpft - vaccinated, **g**enesen – recovered, **g**etestet - tested).
- If the national average reaches this level , the 3G-Rule applies nationwide.
- From an incidence of 35 upwards all facilities are open for persons who are fully vaccinated or recovered. For certain events/services all other persons have to be tested negatively . (test evidence not older than 48h max.)
- School-age children or adolescents are automatically considered tested because of the testing at school (submit school ID)
- Children up to the age of school entry do not need a Corona test, as they are equated to tested persons
- Regardless of the incidence level the obligation to wear a medicinal mask remains.



- Upon entry from a high incidence area there is the obligation of a quarantine of 10 days for persons who are not vaccinated. This can be shortened with a negative test after 5 days at the earliest.

The vaccination centre in Wuppertal closes at the end of September - 2 vaccination sites in Wuppertal

The vaccination centre in Wuppertal closes on Sept. 30th, 2021. Until the closure you can get vaccinated without an appointment. From mid-September there are fixed vaccination dates in Elberfeld and Barmen.

Vaccination campaigns at the House of Integration

On Sept. 16th the second vaccination campaign at the House of Integration takes place. An appointment for this date is not necessary. Persons willing to be vaccinated can come spontaneously between 9a.m. and 2:30p.m. Primary vaccinations and second vaccinations are possible. The vaccination is carried out with



Biontech (mRNA-vaccine) and the vaccine Johnson & Johnson (Here only one vaccination is necessary) .
Only persons from the age of 16 are vaccinated.

Information for children, pupils and parents

Current Corona regulations at the schools

1. In-classroom teaching independent on the incidence

The new Corona regulation settles that schooling is no longer dependent on certain incidence levels.

2. Educational material and expansion of the vaccination offer

In order to raise the vaccination rate among the population , a further vaccination offer is established for **students of Sekundarstufe II** (fifth and sixth form classes).

3. How to proceed in case of risk contacts (Quarantine)

At the moment the rules concerning quarantine at schools are being discussed in order to establish a uniform approach. Currently (Sept. 7th) there is no agreement in the discussion, so that further changes are possible. Get the information directly at your child's school or at the site of the school ministry. Integrational and professional language courses

In the integrational and professional language courses special hygiene and protection rules continue to apply, so that the danger of infection will decrease continually.

Entrance to language schools is only possible in accordance with the 3-G-Rule, i.e. a vaccination certificate, proof of recovery or a negative Corona-19-test has to be submitted.

To protect yourself and others the Corona vaccination is important. You can find information on the Corona virus and on the Corona vaccination in 23 languages on the site of the Federal Commissioner for Integration.
