Please note: The Corona regulations are constantly adapted to the infection process. Therefore there may be changes at short notice. (status Dec. 17th, 2021)

General information

New Corana measures

- 2G (completely vaccinated or recovered) now also applies to the retail trade
- Exempt are shops for daily need, as e.g. grocery stores, pharmacies, chemist's shops, petrol stations, etc.
- People who do **not** conform with the 2G requirements are only allowed to meet with persons from their own household as well as a maximum of two persons of a further household.
- Children up to the age of 13 included are exempt.
- Spouses, life partners (not married) are considered as one household even without a common residence .



- On New Year's Eve public fireworks are forbidden.
- Furthermore public dancing and disco events are not possible.

Booster vaccination against Covid-19

- The vaccination before should have taken place 5 months before, but has to have occurred at least 4 months before.
- For the booster vaccination an appointment is compulsory.

Vaccination of children

- A parent can book the appointment for a child aged 5 to 11. The requirements are:
- The child has to be free of any infection. (This is examined before the vaccination)
- In case the child was infected with the Corona virus there have to be at least 6 months between the infection and the vaccination.
- During the pre-treatment consultation one custodian has to be present.
