Dear readers,

due to the dangerous Corona situation in Germany new Corona measures shall be introduced or even tightened. With this special edition we will give you an overview of the current situation.

**Please note: The Corona regulations are constantly adapted to the infection process. Therefore there may be further changes at short notice. (status: Nov. 23rd, 2021)**

### New Corona measures (status Nov. 23rd, 2021) – important information!

- As of now nationwide access restrictions are in place in the leisure area for persons who are not vaccinated or not recovered.
- The 2G-rule is in place for gastronomy, Christmas markets, football events and other sports events.
- An increase in monetary fines in case of non-compliance with the rules was also decided.
- The 3G-rule for public transport (busses and trains) is in place. (3G-rule: vaccinated, recovered or tested)
- For the workplace the 3G-rule applies. It is controlled and documented by the employer on a daily basis.

### 2G, 2G plus, 3G, 3G plus, - What does it mean?

- **2G** means that only vaccinated or recovered persons are allowed access to certain areas (e.g. gastronomy, Christmas markets, etc.)
- **2G plus** means that vaccinated and recovered persons have to carry with them an additional negative test. (e.g. in discos)
- **3G** means you have to be vaccinated, recovered or tested negatively (antigen quick test or PCR-test).



- **3G Plus** means vaccinated, recovered or tested negatively. However the PCR-test must not be older than 24 hours max and the quick test 6 hours max.

### 3G at your work place? What does it mean? What obligation of proof does the employee have?

- For the work place the 3G-rule applies, too
- At your work place you are obliged to carry with you the proof of vaccination or recovery or a current certificate of a negative Corona test.
- This is controlled and documented by your employer on a daily basis.
- Employers are obliged to offer for all persons working on site an antigen quick test or self test at least twice a week.
- The employer has to offer the possibility of home office for the employees, if there is no conflict with imperative operational reasons.

### Booster vaccination

A booster vaccination with an mRNAQ-vaccine (Biontech/Moderna) 6 months after the second vaccination is strongly recommended for the following persons:

- persons aged over 70
- persons with immunodeficiency
- inhabitants in care facilities as well as people cared for and staff
- staff in medical facilities in direct contact with patients
- The vaccinations can be arranged via registered doctors. Contact your practitioner, please.
